Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed amendments to the Tax Court Rules of Practice and Procedure, announced by press release dated January 22, 2024. The Court proposes to delete existing Rule 13(c) and revise subsections of other Rules that address the Court's jurisdiction.
