PRESS RELEASE

After assessing continuing public health and other factors relating to nationwide COVID-19 cases, the U.S. Tax Court has determined that it is not appropriate to conduct in-person proceedings from February 1 through February 25, 2022. Accordingly, these trial sessions are modified as follows:
