Chief Judge Kathleen Kerrigan announced today that Kashi Way and Adam B. Landy were sworn in as Judges of the United States Tax Court.

Kashi Way

Judge Way previously served for 19 years as staff on the Joint Committee on Taxation of the United States Congress in the roles of Legislative Counsel from 2005 to 2015 and Senior Legislative Counsel from 2015 to 2024. From 2001 to 2005, Judge Way was an Associate Attorney at Covington & Burling, LLP, in Washington, DC. Judge Way served as a Law Clerk to the Honorable Joseph H. Gale of the United States Tax Court from 1999 to 2001.

Judge Way holds a B.A. from the University of Southern California, an M.A. from Columbia University, and a J.D. from the University of Virginia, where he was Editor-in-Chief of the Virginia Tax Review.

Judge Way was appointed by President Biden as Judge of the United States Tax Court and sworn in on August 7, 2024, for a term ending August 6, 2039.

Adam B. Landy

Judge Landy previously served as a Special Trial Judge of the United States Tax Court since 2021. Prior to joining the Court, Judge Landy was a Senior Attorney with the Internal Revenue Service Office of Chief Counsel from 2016 to 2021. From 2010 to 2016, Judge Landy was an Associate Attorney at McNair Law Firm, P.A. (now Burr & Forman, LLP).

Judge Landy holds a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry and a Master of Science in Sport and Entertainment Management from the University of South Carolina, a Juris Doctor from the University of South Carolina School of Law, and a Master of Laws in Taxation from the Northwestern University Pritzker School of Law.
